EURO APPLICATION MATERIALS NEEDED:

- § One Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence undergraduate student application form.
- § One letter of recommendation (preferably from the student's academic advisor). Letter should address the value, relevance and quality of the submitted paper.
- § Current transcript of IU undergraduate work (unofficial transcript sufficient), and CV or resume.
- § A research paper related to any aspect of European politics, society, or culture, whether current or historical in scope. The paper may have been part of coursework at IU or an honors' thesis. The paper should be a minimum of 10 double-spaced pages in length, written in English, and have been completed within the last academic year.
- § A statement of 500 words or less describing educational goals, career interests, and plans. The statement should also describe how the award monies will further the applicant's academic progress and ultimately help achieve career goals.
